DECISION

On March 14, 198 Petitioner, Angelita Manzano, a Filipino Citizen with address at 14 Gregorio Roxas, Queazon City, filed four (4) Petitions for cancellation docketed as Inter Partes Cases Nos. 1823, 1824, 1825 and 1826 for the cancellation, respectively, of –

- (1) Letters Patent No. D-648 issued March 1, 1972 1st Extension - D-218 issued April 29, 1977
 - 2nd Extension D-510 issued May 10, 1982
- (2) Letters patent No. D-649 issued March 1, 1972
 1st Extension D-219 issued April 29, 1977
 2nd Extension D-557 issued October 7, 1982
- (3) Letters patent No. D-650 issued March 1, 1972
 1st Extension D-220 issued April 29, 1977
 2nd Extension D-509 issued May 10, 1982
- (4) Letters Patent No. UM- 1018 issued Sept. 7, 1972
 1st Extension UM-293 issued Sept. 26, 1977
 2nd Extension UM-602 issued November 2, 1982

All issued to Respondent-Patentee, Ang Guan Le, assignor to New United Foundry Manufacturing Corporation, a domestic corporation located at 595 Bo. Bagbag, Novaliches, Quezon City.

Section 58 of Republic Act 165, as amended, reads:

"SEC. 58. Term and extension thereof.- the term of the design patent and of the patent for a utility model shall be five years from the date of the great thereof. (As amended by Republic Act No. 864)

Before the expiration of the five-year term, upon payment of the required fee, or within a further time thereafter not to exceed six months upon payment of the surcharge, the owner of the design patent or of a patent for a utility model may apply for an extension for an additional five years. The application for extension must be accompanied by an affidavit showing that the design or the model is in commercial or industrial use in the Philippines or satisfactorily explaining non-use. In a similar manner an extension for a third five-year period may be obtained." (As amended by Republic Act No. 864)

The fifteen-year term of the subject patents having lapsed, these cases are rendered moot.

WHEREFORE, Inter Partes Cases No. 1823, 1824, 1825 and 1826 are hereby DISMISSED.

Let the records of these cases be remanded to the Patent/Trademark Registry and EDP Division for appropriate action in accordance with this Decision.
