## ORDER

On 26 March 2014, the parties filed a "JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT BASED ON COMPROMISE AGREEEMENT" moving for a judgment based on a compromise agreement entered by the parties. The parties submitted a copy of the "COMPROMISE AGREEMENT" and maintain that this agreement and any and all of its terms, conditions, and obligations shall be binding against each party and their successors and assigns.

In this regard, a review of the provisions of the compromise agreement shows that the agreement is not contrary to law, public policy, morals or good customs. In addition, the settlement of this case is consistent to the policy of encouraging the use of alternative dispute resolution methods and actively promoting party autonomy in the resolution of disputes or the freedom of the parties to make their own arrangements to resolve their disputes.1

Wherefore, premises considered, the COMPROMISE AGREEMENT is hereby included in the records of this case. The parties are enjoined to faithfully comply with the provisions of their agreement. Accordingly, the instant appeal is hereby dismissed. Let a copy of this Order and the records of this case be furnished and returned to the Director of Bureau of Legal Affairs for appropriate action. Let also the Director of Bureau of Patents and the library of the Documentation, Information and Technology Transfer Bureau be furnished a copy of this Order for information, guidance, and records purposes.
