ORDER

CLARIS LIFESCIENCES PHILIPPINES, INC. ("Respondent-Applicant") filed on 05 March 2015 a Manifestation. The Manifestation states, among other things, that:

"2. Although Claris believes that there is no confusing similarity between "NORSALIN" and "NORSULIN", Claris is no longer interested in pursuing the case and trademark application for business reasons."

This Bureau treats the Respondent-Applicant's manifestation as a voluntary abandonment of its trademark application. With the voluntary abandonment by the Respondent-Applicant of its trademark application, there is no more factual or legal basis to proceed with this case.
