ORDER

BEIERSDORF AG ("Opposer"), filed on 14 February 2011 an opposition to Trademark Application Serial No. 4-2010-004188. The application, filed by EUROHEALTHCARE EXPONENTS INC., CO. LTD., ("Respondent-Applicant"), covers the mark "EUROCIN" for use on goods under Class 5.

This Bureau issued a Notice to Answer and served a copy thereof upon the Respondent-Applicant on 15 April 2011. However, the Respondent-Applicant did not file its Answer.

On 17 March 2014, the Opposer filed an Ex-Parte Manifestation stating that a check with the Bureau of Trademarks indicates that the Respondent-Applicant failed to file its 3rd year Declaration of Actual Use (DAU) in relation to the subject trademark application. It says that the Respondent-Applicant's failure to file the DAU will cause the cancellation of the said application. Attached to the Opposer's Ex-Parte Manifestation is a Certification issued by the Bureau of Trademarks on 17 March 2014.

The records of the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines, in particular the Trademarks Registry, confirm the Opposer's allegation. Accordingly, with the abandonment of the application for registration of the mark EUROCIN, there is no more reason nor basis to proceed with this case.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the instant opposition case is hereby DISMISSED. Let the filewrapper of Trademark Registration No4-2010-004188 be returned, together with a copy of this Order to the Bureau of Trademarks (BOT) for information and appropriate action.
