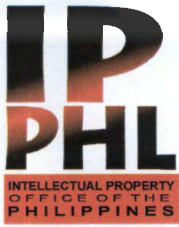

ORDER

THE LINCOLN ELECTRIC COMPANY (“Complainant”) filed on 18 November 2016 a complaint for alleged Trademark Infringement and/or Unfair Competition against KEN-TOOL HARDWARE CORPORATION, ANTONIO F. LIM, MARJORIE ANN S. LIM, NICOLE JOHN S. LIM, MICHAEL F. LIM and MARGARETTE S. LIM (“Respondents”).

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations on Administrative Complaints for Violation of Laws Involving Intellectual Property Rights, this Bureau issued a Notice to Answer and served a copy thereof to Respondents on 27 January 2017.


On 27 February 2017, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss on the ground that they have settled the case amicably to their full and mutual satisfaction.
