ORDER

In compliance to Order No. 2012-887 issued by this Bureau, the Opposer filed on 11 July 2012 a Manifestation submitting the original of the signed and notarized Declaration of Abandonment/Withdrawal of Trademark Application from the Respondent-Applicant with stamped mark indicating receipt of the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines and payment of fees. The Opposer moves to withdraw the instant opposition and for the approval of the Compromise Agreement.

This Bureau finds that the Compromise Agreement has been duly entered into by the parties with the terms and conditions thereof not contrary to law, morals, good custom, public order or public policy.

In this regard, an approved Compromise Agreement shall have the effect of a decision or judgment on the case and shall be enforced accordingly in accordance with the pertinent Rules of IPO and the Rules of Court (Sec. 5, Office Order No. 154, s. 2010).

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the parties' Compromise Agreement is hereby APPROVED. With the approved Compromise Agreement having the force and effect of a decision or judgment, the parties are hereby enjoined to faithfully comply with the terms set forth therein. Accordingly, the instant opposition is hereby DISMISSED.

Let the filewrapper of Trademark Application Serial No. 4-2010-005541 be returned, together with a copy of this Order and the aforementioned Manifestation of the Opposer, to the Bureau of Trademarks for information and appropriate action.
