
Please be informed that Order No. 2017 - 126 (D) dated May 31, 2017 (copy enclosed) was promulgated in the above entitled case.

ORDER

THE NET-A-PORTER GROUP LIMITED ("Opposer") filed on 25 April 2017 a Manifestation that:

- "1. Thereafter, and subsequent to the submission by Respondent-Applicant of its Verified Answer, this Honorable Bureau issued Order No. 2016-117 dated July 5, 2016 referring case to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Services for the conduct of mediation proceedings.
- 2. Opposer manifests that during the course of the mediation proceedings, the Parties were also directly engaged in global settlement discussions. Pursuant to such discussions, Opposer has determined that it is no longer interested in pursuing the subject Opposition against application for registration of the **PORTER GIRL** mark."

This Bureau treats the Opposer's manifestation as a voluntary withdrawal of its opposition. With the voluntary withdrawal by the Opposer of its opposition, there is no more factual or legal basis to proceed with this case.
